Abstract: *Searching for fundamental freedoms, independence, security and prosperity were the main drivers of changes and political elections from the countries of Central and Oriental Europe in the last twenty years. The image of the Western Europe was perceived by the former Soviet countries' population as an association between the individual politic freedoms and the economic welfare.*
